

**ROANOKE REGIONAL AIRPORT COMMISSION  
INVITATION TO BID  
CARRIER VEHICLE WITH SPREADER AND 22 FOOT PLOW**

The Roanoke Regional Airport Commission requests and will consider sealed bids for **CARRIER VEHICLE WITH SPREADER AND 22 FOOT PLOW**. The specifications for the **CARRIER VEHICLE WITH SPREADER AND 22 FOOT PLOW** generally conform to FAA Advisory Circular AC 150/5220-20A unless otherwise specifically described in the detailed technical specifications.

Sealed bids will be received in the Administrative Offices of the Roanoke Regional Airport Commission located on the second floor of the terminal building, 5202 Aviation Drive, Roanoke, Virginia 24012, **until 2:00 p.m., May 10, 2017** at which time and place all Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud for the following equipment purchase at Roanoke, Virginia:

Bidders are invited to submit Bids for this work on the Bid Forms provided in the Contract Documents; other Bid Forms will not be accepted.

A complete examination and understanding of the Contract Documents, including the Specifications, are necessary to properly submit a Bid. Contract Documents are available for examination at/or may be obtained from the office of the Roanoke Regional Airport Commission, 5202 Aviation Drive, Roanoke, Virginia 24012.

A Certified or Cashier's Check on any national or state bank or a Bid Bond on the form found in the Contract Documents in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount bid, made payable to the Roanoke Regional Airport Commission, must accompany each Bid as a guarantee that the Bidder will not withdraw its Bid for a period of 90 days after opening of the bids, and in the event the Contract is awarded to the Bidder, it will, within 15 days after Notice of Award and Acceptance of its bid, enter into a contract with the Roanoke Regional Airport Commission, failing which it shall forfeit the amount of the Bid Bond as liquidated damages. The Bid Bond is required to be secured from a Surety, which shall be duly licensed to conduct business in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The Roanoke Regional Airport Commission, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Statute 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that, in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be offered full opportunity to submit bids in response to this Invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, gender, or national origin in consideration for its award.

This purchase will be funded with federal AIP, State aviation and local funds. All bidders agree to comply with all applicable regulations governing the receipt of such funds.

Each Bid submitted shall be placed with attachments in an opaque 9 x 12 inch envelope which shall be sealed. Said envelope shall be plainly marked on the bottom left hand corner with:

and with the name and address of the Bidder in the upper left hand corner. Each Bid shall be delivered to the Roanoke Regional Airport Commission at the place stated for receiving bids or mailed to the Roanoke Regional Airport Commission Offices, Second Floor Terminal Building, 5202 Aviation Drive, Roanoke, Virginia 24012. Attention: Commission Secretary. If mailed, the Bid shall be sent by certified mail, or overnight express carrier, with return receipt requested. No Bid will be considered unless received on or before the time and at the place designated above.

The Bidder must fill in all information required by the Bid Forms.

The Roanoke Regional Airport Commission reserves the right to waive any informalities, technicalities, or irregularities in a Bid, or to reject any or all bids, or to re-advertise for bids and to award or refrain from awarding the Contract.

This Contract is subject to the provisions of Executive Order 11246-Affirmative Action to insure Equal Employment Opportunity; Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; Department of Transportation Regulations 49 CFR Part 21-Nondiscrimination in Benefits for Services to the Public, 49-CFR Part 123 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation, and 49 CFR Part 30-Denial of Public Works Contracts to Suppliers of Goods and Services of Countries that deny procurement market access to the U.S. Contractors (Foreign Trade Restriction); and Buy American-Steel and Manufactured Products Provision of the Aviation Safety and Capacity Expansion Act of 1990.
