Bids are hereby solicited from qualified companies to furnish all labor, materials, parts and supplies necessary for scheduled maintenance services and related repairs for two (2) Burnham 100hp boilers for a period of three (3) years at Roanoke Blacksburg Regional Airport.

Bids must be submitted to the Commission's Administrative Offices according to the guidelines contained in the IFB.

Bids will be accepted at the Roanoke Regional Airport Commission administrative offices until 2:00 P.M. on July 10, 2019. The offices are located on the second floor of the Terminal. The Airport is located at 5202 Aviation Drive, Roanoke, VA 24012.

A pre-bid meeting will be held in Conference Room "A" of the Commission offices on June 27, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. and the work sites will be shown to bidders by a Commission representative following the pre-bid meeting to assist bidders in preparing their bid packages. Any interested bidder should arrive at the Commission's offices, second floor of Terminal building by the specified time in order to view the site. There will be no additional meetings or site reviews.

This procurement is subject to and governed by the Virginia Public Procurement Act, as amended, as modified by the Roanoke Regional Airport Commission Procurement Regulations, as amended, which are incorporated by reference herein.
